

*Bat & Moth



Children form a large circle. One child is chosen as the bat and two or three as moths and they go inside the circle. The bat is blindfolded. The bat calls 'bat,bat,bat' and immediately the moths must answer 'moth,moth,moth' and using this method the bat must try and catch the moths. If the bat touches a moth then that moth is 'eaten' and must leave the circle. The children in the circle can be asked to watch to see which moths use the most effective ways of avoiding being caught (speed, speaking quietly, ducking) showing the principle of the survival of the fittest.
